## Careful... Ready... AWAY!!

It is a sequence present in the minds of many people, especially those who will want to reactivate their activity with the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.

We do not want and can not overlap with the decisions of the Italian Government, which will dictate the Guiding Standards, very simply we want to mention **some cornerstones that will have to be kept in mind**anyway.

The following applies to companies with daily working hours, the same guidelines must be adjusted for other types of hours.

Each company, with the **support of its competent physician** (where present), will have to issue a number of provisions aimed at **reducing the possibility of contagion** for its staff, following the guidance provided by the health authorities. Each Employer will have to **inform all staff** of the COVID-19 risk.

It is important to warn any **contractors**in charge of cleaning up the premises, so that the employer of the latter takes all the necessary **precautions** in accordance with Article 26 D. Lgs. 81/2008.

From an operational point of view, it is essential to **sanitize** the workplace at every start of the day.

Staff with administrative and commercial tasks will have to use **smart-working** as much as possible to reduce the chances of contagion.

You will have to **measure the body temperature** of each incoming operator who will have to be equipped with masks **and gloves.** 

In the case of personnel who during the activity should present symptoms related to the **infection** should be directed to a special segregated area and in possession of windows that can be opened and **alert** the designated health facilities for this event.

In production departments **and warehouses**, at least one metre between operators must be maintained. un metro di distanza fra un Operatore e l'altro.

If this is not possible, it is necessary to advise the Head of Department and Employer to pay more attention to these Operators who will have to provide with technical interventions able to guarantee the principle of the **spacer criterion**.

Proper **cleaning of premises** and workstations, more easily affected by workers and external users, must be properly cleaned up by the use of suitable disinfectant and sanitizing products.

**Common rooms** such as canteens and changing rooms will have to be accessible as long as you can respect the distance of at least one **meter** between two people, ditto for theand Saland iReunion.

Guests should be checked as operators and wear masks and gloves if they do not.

After their exit will have to be sanitized the premises that will have occupied.

When the staff leaves the company, any assembly should be avoided, again on this occasion imposing a metre between two people.
